Shiraz

Deep crimson in colour with garnet hues, fragrant aromas of ripe plum, blue and black berry fruits, spice, sage and fresh bay leaf with notes of tar and cedar. These aromas follow through to the palate with dark fruits, spice and herbaceous nuances, tightly wound balanced acidity, textured layers and long tannins.

A luscious and layered aroma of plum, blackberries and spice. The palate is deliciously complex with nutmeg, cinnamon, rhubarb and plum. An elegant wine with great balance and restrained use of oak.

Depth in colour with vibrant purple hues. Layered aromatics; cedary oak, dark fruited Cabernet aromas and brambly notes creating varietal distinction.

Head Honcho was created from single cabernet vineyard which produces small berries full of intense flavour, containing no pesticides and only using organic additives, this wine has been aged for over 24 months in the finest French oak barrels with only 3 barrels making the cut this year creating only 100 cases

Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz 33rd Vintage

Black Label is built on persistence of flavour, seamless texture and long, velvety tannins. Opulent yet elegant fruit provides richness, depth and exceptional complexity. Deep purple in colour with medium intensity of aromas on the nose, featuring blackberry, cherry, coffee, chocolate, black pepper and spice flavourings.

Mataro/ Grenache

Deep in colour with a rich complex on the nose, palate is rich, warm with very broad levels of tannins and acid. Earthy yet fruity with plum and black cherry. Best enjoyed with a section of cheese.

Merlot

Richly layered palate of dark plum and cherry with hints of chocolate and vanillin oak combined with a soft, earthy note. Very fine and smooth tannins add to the complexity and mouthfeel. Featuring blackberries, olives, mocha and dark chocolate.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Excellent dark berry fruits with French oak characters, the palate has almost a medium bodied weight, with plum and spice flavours leaving you with refreshing long fine tannins.

Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon

Displaying black current with a hint of plum. An elegant style with spice and cedar with soft sandy tannins. Mocha and a hint of Cabernet mint and leaf.

Riesling

Riesling is the darling of Alsace, and a favourite of wine lovers worldwide. With a fresh fruit and vibrant profile often with an appealing minerality shining through. Often mistaken as a sweet wine it is classified as a dry to off dry versions that are all extraordinarily food friendly. Riesling can be present differently depending on region, age and winemaking, bone dry through to sweeter styles. Australia's Riesling character trends toward aromas of citrus and florals with a fresh and dry palate. Riesling is wonderfully suited to an array of food types.

Pinot Gris/Grigio

Known as the grey grape, the difference between Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio is their origins, Grigio from Italy and Gris from France, ones that are made in Australia and NZ are similar to those of Italy and lean towards a fresher, lighter, more minerally and at times spritzy wines. Pinot Gris are traditionally richer and more textural. Pinot Gris is quickly becoming one of the most popular all occasion white wines and are best consumed young unless you look to Alsace where the natural acidity and slight sweetness assists them to age gracefully.

Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir traditionally presents slightly lighter than most reds delivering cherry and red fruit notes when young, other character include spice, barnyard and toasty barrel notes which deliver greater complexity. There is nothing light about the structure of a well-made pinot noir as it gives up power, texture and a length of palate that rivals any red grape variety.

Shiraz

Shiraz is Australia's most popular choice of red wines. The rich, ripe and intense characters of the different regions are driving these wines. The Syrah also known as Shiraz wines are responsible for some of the darkest full-bodied red wines in the world. It has dark fruit flavours from sweet blueberry to savoury black olive. When you taste Shiraz, you will be greeted with a punch of flavour that tapers off and then has a spicy peppery note in the aftertaste.

Cabernet Sauvignon & Blends

The home of Cabernet Sauvignon is in Bordeaux. However, Australia has found great success growing it, especially in the regions of Coonawarra and Margaret River. Cabernet Sauvignon is a small dark grape that commonly shows cassis, violet, chocolate and mint, however it changes from region to region. Australia has the Coonawarra, Margaret River to name a few fine regions creating exceptional cabernet sauvignon. Bordeaux blends commonly consists of cabernet sauvignon and merlot, including cabernet franc, malbec and petit Verdot. The respected Australian blend of cabernet sauvignon and Shiraz delivers a powerful wine, as cabernet offers the back bone and structure whilst the Shiraz delivers the weight and sweetness derived from fruit.
